




Photograph 1. Pennsylvania Turnpike: Delaware River Extension, general view to east near MP 327.3.




Photograph 2. Pennsylvania Turnpike, view to southeast toward proposed east bridge crossing location in PECO right-of-way at MP 328.5.



Photograph 3. Pennsylvania Turnpike, view to southwest from King of Prussia Service Plaza, showing proposed KOP Rail Project elevated track location.














